Forney museum, Big Boy display and railcars

Denver Union Station

Ride the Denver trolley system

Georgetown Loop, train yards and museum in Silverthorne

Boulder--- Valmont area—train club grounds just off of Valmont road

Denver depot

Trip to the east side of the Needle-eye Tunnel above Nederland.

Two days or more trips:

Leadville—west a few miles to the Hagermann tunnel, probably can be an all day trip just hiking the old train bed.

Ride the Leadville train to Climax and back

Como—town and touring the round house, depot of the Denver South Part and Pacific (on the way to Fairplay)

From Como it is an historic drive down on the old train bed past a water tower

To Breckenridge (display of an old steam engine)
