Northern Colorado Garden Railroaders

Garden railroading brings model railroading outdoors with real scenery. Layouts can be as simple as a loop of track on existing terrain, or dedicated landscaping in a garden full of scale plants, buildings, bridges, and streams. The fact that the railroad is outdoors promotes involvement from family, friends, and neighbors. A garden railroad is a dynamic display, changing with the seasons.

Scale

Most garden railroads run on the same gauge track, 1.75" (45mm) between the rails. Standard gauge models are 1:29 or 1:32 scale. Narrow gauge models are 1:24, 1:22.5, or 1:20.3 scale. All referred to as "Large Scale".

Purpose

The Northern Colorado Garden Railroaders is a non-profit organization composed of men and women, of all ages, dedicated to sharing knowledge and providing fellowship and support to all those interested in the hobby of garden railroading.

Monthly Meetings

Third Wednesday of each month. In summer months we meet at member's homes with operational garden railroads. In Winter, an indoor location where members exchange ideas, show projects and learn more about the hobby.

Hobo Breakfast

Monthly. Usually in Fort Collins or Loveland.

Special Events

Annual Picnic, Rail Fan Trips, Swap Meets. Promotion of the hobby to the public.

Garden Railroad Tours

Organized tours of member's garden railroads, running trains, allow NCGR members, other front range garden railroad clubs, and the



community to see the variety of techniques and concepts used in building a garden railroad. Every garden railroad is unique.

Tours can help you make many of the initial decisions required to get your own garden railroad started.
